Program Overview

Fabretto is launching a Child Sponsorship program in Honduras to empower underserved children through education. Building upon over 20 years of experience running a Child Sponsorship program in Nicaragua, we are partnering with the local nonprofit ACOES Honduras to help children access education and nutrition services, while working together to improve education quality in rural Honduras. Join us and sponsor a child in Honduras today!

Why Honduras?

- Children need access to education: Over 750,000 Honduran children ages 5-17 are not in school.
- Children need support to stay in school: Only 50% of the children who enroll in 1st grade will reach the 9th grade, and just 30% will reach the last year of high school.
- Children need quality education: 70% of third graders are not meeting standards in reading, according to the 2019 national ERCE tests - and pandemic school closures have led to greater learning loss, especially in the most rural communities.





Our Local Partner

Fabretto is proud to partner with Fundación ACOES Honduras, founded in 1992 by Padre Patricio Larrosa with the goal of reducing inequality in the most vulnerable communities of Honduras. ACOES runs a network of schools, preschools, and afterschool education centers across Honduras and supports thousands of children in public schools. ACOES is almost entirely run by youth volunteers, who receive university scholarships and develop leadership and on-the-job skills through their service.



Your Impact

Our model includes both direct benefits for your sponsored child and resources that are pooled to make an impact on education quality in your sponsored child's community. When you sponsor a child in rural Honduras through Fabretto, the child will receive:

- A full set of school supplies, such as a backpack, uniform, and school materials, to enable the child to attend school
- · A special gift at the end of each year
- Access to educational support and daily meals at our local partner's education center
- · Personalized follow up throughout the year
- Improved education quality through projects organized by Fabretto to strengthen education in the child's community benefitting not only the individual child, but also the whole school. Projects respond to each community's needs (such as teacher training, classroom materials, improving school infrastructure)



How Sponsorship Works

Your contribution of \$40 per month will enable a child to access education and improve education quality for the whole community. You will receive:

- · A profile of your sponsored child
- · A back to school letter each year
- An end of year card and updated photo
- The opportunity to exchange letters throughout the year and/or visit your sponsored child in Honduras





FAQ

- Is my donation fully tax deductible? Yes! Fabretto is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in the U.S.
- How can I communicate with my sponsored child? You are encouraged to write letters to your sponsored child throughout the year, or we'd be happy to help you plan your visit to Honduras.
- How is this program different from the program in Nicaragua? In Nicaragua, Fabretto ran its own education centers. In Honduras, we are partnering with ACOES to run programs on the ground, supported by our team, including an in-country sponsorship liaison to ensure program quality.
- How much of my donation goes to work in Honduras? 90% of your donation goes directly to programs. The remainder funds monitoring, sponsor communication, and administration.
